

## Governor urges students to help others through blood, platelets

Governor Anandiben Patel urged students of Khwaja Moinuddin Chishti Language University for blood and platelets donation which, she said, would get them more than winning the gold medal.

The Governor was speaking at the sixth convocation of Khwaja Moinuddin Chishti Language University held on Tuesday. Recalling the present pandemic period, she said it was unfortunate that so many people died for want of blood.

"Everyone has a role or function to play. I had first thought about every university and affiliated organising blood donation camps from time to time. I think the universities should do this at least once a year. We have twice a year a blood donation camp for students to help patients in need. Students need to be made aware that the blood is required constantly," she said.

The Governor also said that students should be held a programme at RAI Bhawan where 200 students registers for platelets donation.


"Whenever required, they will be available by doctors and asked to reach the hospital," she pointed out.
